First returned to Parlt. of Nova Scotia 1867 and retained seat until 1871. Again elected at last g.e. His opponent in 1867 was Horeham Blanchard, Esq., for some time Attorney-General of the Province. Liberal Conservative. First returned to Parlt., for present seal, Sept. 1872, on resignation of sitting mem.; re-elected at g.e. 1874, and again at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative.—Port Hood, N.S.

FORD, LEANDER STARR. [Queen's.]

Descended from an old loyalist family, from Mass. U.S., on his father's side; and from the McLeod clan, on his mother's. B. Ed. and M. in Milton, Queen's Co. N.S. B. 23 Dec. 1836. M. a dau. of the late Zoheth Freeman, Esq. of Milton, 1860. Is First Major of Queen's Co. Militia. A carriage manufacturer. A Liberal Conservative. Believes in Protection and Civic Service reform. The case would be extreme when he would advocate discharging an efficient public servant. An advocate of Prohibition on the Temperance Question. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e.—Milton, Queen's Co. N.S.
