misdemeanor with which he may stand charged, and to render a true verdict according to the evidence upon the issue joined between the parties.

To punish those found guilty.

IV. If the person so charged shall be found guilty of the offence for which he shall be so arraigned and tried, then the Judge shall sentence in him to such punishment as the law awards to the crime of which he shall be so found guilty as aforesaid.

And discharge those not guilty.

V. If the person so charged shall be found not guilty, then the Judge shall direct his immediate discharge from the custody of the Sheriff as afforesaid.
