I.—REGULATION AND MANAGEMENT OF  
THE HOUSE.

Time of  
meeting.

**1.** The time for the ordinary meeting of the House is at three o'clock in the afternoon of each sitting day, and if at that hour there be not a quorum, Mr. Speaker may take the chair and adjourn. When the House rises on Friday, it shall stand adjourned, unless otherwise ordered, until the following Monday.—B. 290, 298. M. 236.

Evening  
sittings.

**2.** If at the hour of six o'clock, p.m., the business of the day be not concluded, Mr. Speaker shall leave the chair until half-past seven.—B. 297.

Order in

**3.** When the House adjourns, the Members shall keep their seats until the Speaker has left the chair.—B. 406.
