## BILL.

An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Port Burwell Harbor Company.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act passed Preamble. in the twelfth year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled, "In Act to incorporate certain 12 Vict. "persons under the style and title of the President, Direct5 "ors and Company of Port Burwell Harbor," and to extend the powers of the said Company, to impose and levy tolls on certain articles of lumber and merchandize, not mentioned or enumerated in the Schedule in the said Act contained: Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

10 That from and after the passing of this Act, it shall and company may be lawful for the said President, Directors and Company take tolls on certain pany, to impose, demand, receive, take, levy and collect, articles, with the like powers as in the said Act is provided for the recovery of rates, tolls on the following articles passing out or from the said harbor, not exceeding the rate hereinafter mentioned, and from time to time, to reduce, alter or amend the same, viz.:

On every standard saw log, five shillings.

On every spar or mast, five shillings.

20 On all squared, hewn, sawed, or round timber, two shillings and six pence per hundred feet running measure.
