Dear Mrs. Switzer:

I have yours of 19th.

The filling of any vacancies in the Indian Agencies is done by the Civil Service Commission and not by the Government. Indeed, the Government has no say in the matter at all. Also the law provides that a returned soldier has to have the preference if he is qualified.

I suggest that in your son's application to the Commission he refer to me, and on getting word from the Commission, I will be glad to speak on his behalf.
