(D) At "The Four Portages" on the North shore of the said Lake; about one square mile.

(E) At the mouth of the Sucker River on the West shore of the said Lake; about one square mile.

(F) At Stanley on the Churchill River, adjacent to the Trading post and the Anglican Mission ; about one square mile.

I may add that these six suggested locations correspond roughly with the present grouping of the Indian population in the District; they live for the most part in settlements around the Lake and on the find Churchill River at points which they A most favourable for fish and most convenient for their hunting grounds.
