
(D) At "The Four Portages" on the North shore of the said Lake; about one square mile.

(E) At the mouth of the Sucker River on the West shore of the said Lake; about one square mile.

(F) At Stanley on the Churchill River, adjacent to the Trading post and the Anglican Mission; about one square mile.

I may add that these six suggested locations correspond roughly with the present grouping of the Indian population in the District; they live for the most part in settlements around the Lake and on the Churchill River at points which they find most favourable for fish and most convenient for their hunting grounds.
