Referring to your letter of March 22nd last, reporting on the request of the Roman Catholic Church for the establishment of a day school on the Beren's River Reserve, you state that you checked over the list of children, who would be likely to attend the school, if erected, and conducted under the auspices of the Roman Catholic Church, and ascertained that the number would be about thirty.

To justify the establishment of a day school under Roman Catholic auspices, there must be a sufficient number of children of school age of the Roman Catholic faith, and that is the information that I am seeking. Kindly supply this giving the names of the parents and the ages of the children.
