No. 379. Following is a copy of a telegram received September 13th by the Ministry of Information from Berlin, Begins:

Egyptian, Canadian, Australian, New Zealand, and South African subjects over fifteen years old now in Germany must report personally to the nearest police station within twenty-four hours.

Those under fifteen must be reported in writing or by their legal guardians. Stateless persons whose last State was one of these countries must also apply either personally or in writing. No one covered by this order may leave his present residence without permission. Ends.
