Royalties payable:-

- (a) \$1 per thousand feet board measure on all timber suitable for saw-logs, boomsticks, etc., scaled under the British Columbia log rule.
- (b) 75 cents per cord of 128 cubic feet on all timber suitable for shingle bolts, pulpwood, cordwood or other woods customarily measured by the cord.
- (c) 2 cents per lineal foot on all timber suitable for piling, poles and spars.
- (d) 5 cents per tie and 3 cents per post.

The licensee may operate a portable saw mill on the Reserve, providing that mill debris is disposed of to the satisfaction of the Provincial Forest Service.
