

The Board being of opinion that all the offices of the Society should be under one roof, both on the ground of economy and to secure efficiency of management, have had plans prepared showing how the building could be altered to accommodate the children and officers of the Society, and after careful consideration have adopted a plan that in their judgment is the most economical and effective, and have decided to appeal to the generous public for the assistance necessary to carry out its requirements.

The price paid is \$9,000.00: \$1,500.00 cash, and the balance in annual instalments at 5 per cent. It is necessary to put in new heating and plumbing systems, which, with other alterations, will cost \$7,000.00, making the total cost \$16,000.00.

The Society has no recourse but to appeal to those persons who feel in sympathy with the effort to save unfortunate children from the influences of vice and cruelty, which lead almost certainly to a life ending in shame
