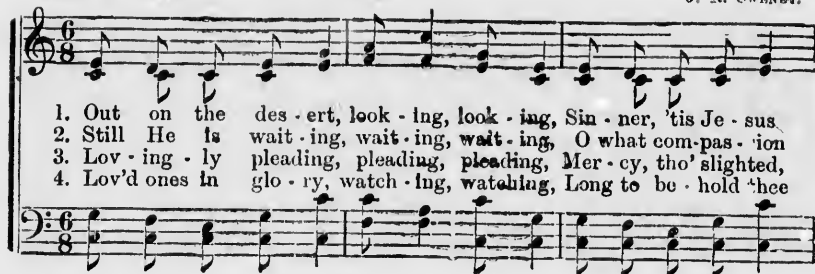

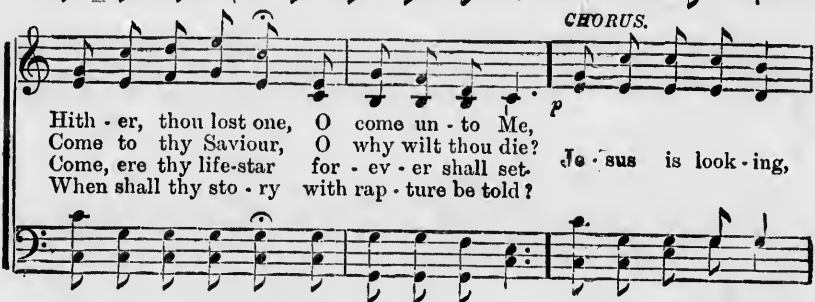

 4. Lov'd ones in glo-ry, watch-ing, watching, Long to be-hold thee

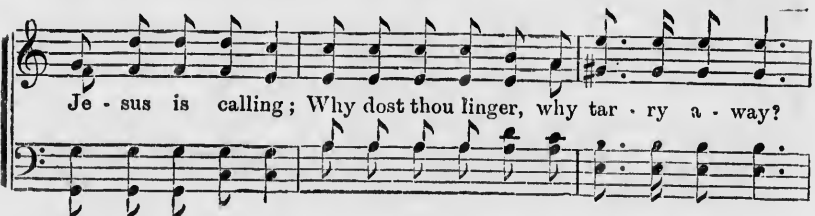


look-ing for thee; Ten-der-ly call-ing, call-ing, call-ing,

 safe in the fold; An-gels are wait-ing, wait-ing, wait-ing,

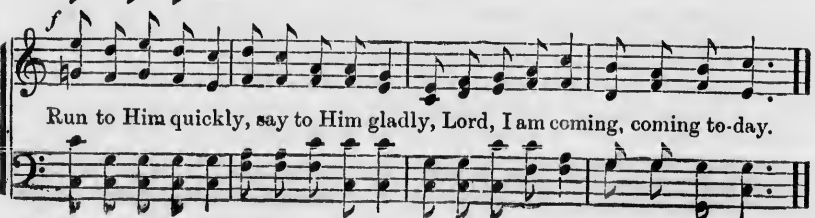


CHORUS.
