

NOTE.—It is absolutely necessary that the alarm be first transmitted to the Water Works Engine House; hence the reason for proceeding first to Rodgers' telephone, King's Ward, which has a telephone direct to Engine House, or to St. Dunstan's Church Bell, or City Hall Bell, which each have electric connection with gong at Water Works.

Remember process in sounding alarm, or repeating on other bells. First: Ring hard half a minute, then count ten slowly, then toll the Ward Signal—one, two, three, four, or five taps as the case may be, then count ten slowly, and repeat the process of ringing hard, etc.
