lean meat and green vegetables and

fresh fruit, plenty of apples, if possible;

if fats and sweets are indulged, the

sedentary worker suffers from con-

stitution and its attendant ills. It is

well to remember that it is not the

amount of food eaten, but the amount

that builds up the body; therefore,

over-eating may be quite as harm-

ful as not eating enough.

People are becoming more and more

convinced that fruit eating, cooked or

raw, but better raw, is a most important

item of diet. The apples seem to

stand first. "There is a proverb to the

effect that, "An apple a day keeps the

doctor away." Those who find it hard

to digest apples should eat a little bread

with them. A ripe apple takes one hour

to digest—stone fruits take a little longer.

From analysis it has been proved

that apples, berries and stone fruits

furnish rich, pure blood, strong muscles

and a clean physical economy generally.

Many doctors declare that grapes are

the most valuable of all fruits. Vegetables

supply a great deal of mineral

matter, the necessary salts for the body.

Lettuce supplies potash, cabbage sul-

phur, potatoes starch, beets sugar, etc.

In conclusion, remember that the most

healthy food for each is that best fitted

to the user, and the cheapest food is

that which has the largest amount of

nutriment at the least cost. In buying

vegetables, often those of medium size

are better than the very large ones.
