of such charges, and the Inspector shall, in his bill of inspection and certificate, conform to the decisions of the Board of Arbitration.

24. Nothing in this Act shall oblige any person to cause Inspection any Wheat or other Grain to be inspected; but if inspected, it not to be compulsory. shall be subject to the provisions of this Act.

CAP. IV.

An Act respecting the Sureties of Public Officers on the Separation of United Counties and Townships.

[Assented to 5th May, 1863.]

HEREAS it is desirable to amend the Law with respect Preamble. to Public Officers of United Counties or Townships, who continue the public officers of the senior County or Township, or remaining Counties or Townships, after the separation of a junior County or Township from the Union, and with respect to the Sureties of such Public Officers: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The separation of a Junior County or Township from a Separation Union of Counties or townships, shall not in any case or in any not to affect manner whatever affect the office, duty, power or responsibility liability of an of any Public Officer of the Union who continues a public officer conof any Fublic Officer of the Chion who combines a public tinuing such officer of the senior County or Township or remaining Counties for the Senior or Townships after such separation, or the sureties of any such County, &c., Officer or their liability, further than by limiting such office, or his sureties. duty, power, responsibility, suretyship and liability to the senior County or Township, or remaining Counties or Townships.

- 2. All such public Officers shall, after such separation, be such officers the officers of the senior County or Township, or remaining to be the offi-cers of the Counties or Townships, as if they had originally been respectively. tively appointed Public Officers for such senior County or &c. Township, or for such remaining Counties or Townships only.
- 3. All sureties for such Public Officers shall be, and remain Liability of liable, as if they had become the sureties for such Public their sureties. Officers, in respect only of such senior County or Township, or of such remaining Counties or Townships; And all securities How securities which have been given shall, after such separation, be read and shall be conconstrued as if they had been given only for such senior or strued remaining County or Counties, or Township or Townships.
- 4. Nothing herein contained shall affect the right of new Right to resureties being required to be given by any Sheriff, or by any quire new Clerk or Bailiff or other public officer, under any statute, or sureties not impaired. otherwise howsoever.
 - 5. This Act shall apply to Upper Canada only.
