3rd & 4th February.

That an Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that he will be pleased to cause to be laid before this House a Return of the names of the several persons employed in the undermentioned offices, the dates of their several appointments, and the amount of annual salary paid to each, viz:

> The Executive Council, Provincial Secretary's Office, Provincial Registrar's Office, Receiver General's Office, Inspector General's Office, Crown Lands Department, Board of Works.

Also a Return of the amount of Revenue received from the Crown Lands for the last five years, distinguishing how much received in each year, and the respective amounts from Upper and Lower Canada.

Also a Return of the names of the persons employed as Collectors of Customs, Landingwaiters, or others in charge of the Revenue of Customs, with the dates of their respective appointments, the amount of salary paid to each annually, and the amount of Revenue collected at each locality, for the years 1856, 1857, and 1858.

After Debate, it was

Ordered, That the said motion be postponed until this day fortnight.

Then on motion of the Honorable Mr. de Blaquière, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Knowlton,
