Synepsis of Canadian North West Land Regulations

Any person who is the sole head of family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of Saskatchewan or Alberta. The appli cant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, sor. daughter, brother or sister of intending

three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on farm of at least 80 acres sclely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sis-

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre Duties-Must reside upon the home

stead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of home stead entry (including the time required a homestead patent) and cultivate fifty A homesteader who has oxbansted

his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$2.60 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifly acres and erect a house worth \$300.00. W W. CORY,
