Public Notice!

The following extracts from "Orders
in Council" respecting the payment
of Pensions and other Allowances
to the dependants of Seamen and
crews of Mercantile vessels engaged
in the export of Newfoundland
produce to market, are published for
general information:—

1.—The master of all sailing vessels
carrying cargoes of Newfoundland
produce to market, shall, before
sailing, forward to the Colonial Secretary,
a statement giving (a) the full name;
(b) Age; (c) Place of Birth; (d)
Residence; (e) A complete statement
of dependants, and (f) the Address
of each of such dependants, of himself
and each of the members of his crew.

2.—The benefit to accrue to such
dependants are similar to those payable
to the dependants of members of
the Royal Naval Reserve, and of
the Royal Newfoundland Regiment,
under "The War Pensions Act, 1917".
Claimants desiring further information
or application forms may obtain
same from the Secretary of the Board
of Pension Commissioners for Newfoundland,
at Room 10, Militia Building,
Water Street, St. John's, East.
All claims will be heard and adjusted
by the Board of Pension Commissioners
for Newfoundland.
