

Washington, D. C., Nov. 23.—Acting Secretary Newberry of the United States navy department received this despatch from Compander Peary, dated Sydney, N. S. today: "I respectfully beg to report my arrival with the Rossevelt this morning. The expedition of the Peary Arctic club, which I have the honor to command, has penetrated the polar basin beyond 87 degrees north eliminating the probability of the existence of any land between the north shores bordering that basin through ten degrees of longitude between parallels 81 and 83, and secured an interesting series of soundings."
