

THE CITY ENGINEERS' BILL

The Executive Engineers' Bill the City Council held a short meeting yesterday afternoon.

The only report considered was that of the Board of Works. The report was referred to the committee on the high level bridge to be submitted to the people for their approval.

At the last meeting of the Board of Works there was a secret sitting, at which it was decided to recommend to the City Council that Mr. East be appointed city engineer and this recommendation was embodied in the report.

The Mayor moved that it be referred back, and in explanation said that there was an understanding that no one name would be recommended at the meeting of the board.

The Mayor stated that he believed that the clause would never have received the sanction of the board had not the part objected to by Mr. East been appended.

The Mayor also recommended that Mr. Jennings be called in as a consulting engineer. Mr. East moved that this latter recommendation be struck out, and the remainder of the clause be referred to the council.
