

GOVERNMENT HÓUSE. OTTAWA.

Thursday, 13th August, 1803, PRESENT:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL

IN COUNCIL.
WHEREAS by an Act passed in the 29th year of
Her Majesty's Reign, intituded: "An Act to

Helters by an Act passed in the 22th years of the Majesty's Reign, intituded: "An Act to provide against the introduction and spreading of disorders affecting certain animals," authority is given to the Governor in Council to take such measures as may appear to be necessary, in order to revent the introduction of contagious or infection disorders affecting gattle and other animals, and to check such disorders from spreading if introduced; And whereas a contagious disease or epidents, affecting Horned Cattle, prevails in many parts of the United States of America, and is increasing and errending its ravages; and whereas it is expedient, in order to prevent the introduction of the same into the Province of Canada, that the importations of Horned Cattle, from the Linited States of America, should be prohibited—

His Excellency in Conneil, on the recommendative of the Honorable the Minister of Customs, and under the attending tyren by the said Act, has been pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered, that from as after the date hereof, and until this order shall have been altered or revoked, the importation from the Linited States of America, or introduction thereof less the Province of Quebec and Ontarro, herecofore constituting the Province of Canada, or into any jett thereof, of Horned Cattle, be and the same is herely prohibited
