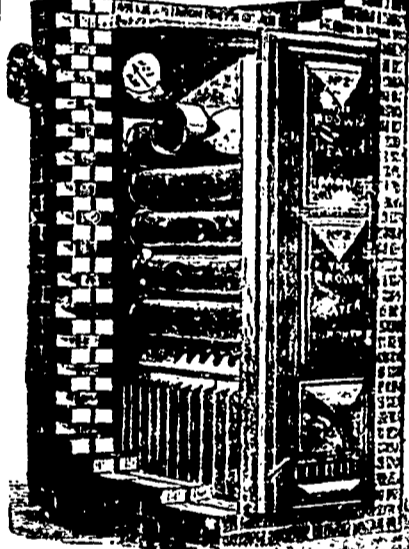

We also find, with the thermometer at 6°, that in 1 hr. 30 min., with one fire, the temperature in the building was 58°, and in less than 3 hrs., 64°, the building then being properly ventilated, 16 cubic feet of wood per day being sufficient to produce the above result. 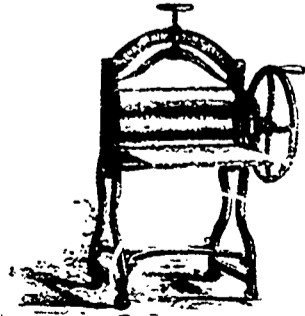
