

loss; but it would not be far wrong to place it at 60 per cent. On that basis, the plaintiffs were entitled, in addition to costs, to judgment as follows: against the British America Assurance Company, to \$1,122 on stock and \$102 on fixtures, or a total of \$1,224; against the Acadia Fire Insurance Company, to \$1,215 on stock and \$88 on fixtures, or a total of \$1,303; and against the Firemen's Fund Insurance Company, to \$1,303 on stock and \$205 on fixtures, or a total of \$1,508.
