QUARTER: 1 -Assist CC in bidding on various gas distribu-
tion projects
-Promote Canadian capability in underground
storage of natural gas
-Promote Canadian capability in sector
-Provide counsel to a Canadian firm to submit
bid on important pipeline project.

-CC is negotiating for construction of pipeline
extension to Ereğli steel mill
-Canadian companies have not followed up
-Minister and General Director of TPAO visiting
Canada in September
-After extensive meetings in Turkey the Cana-
dian company has selected a local partner and
submitted a bid; local info indicates firm is
well placed.

QUARTER: 3 -Assist Novacorp in bidding for engineering ser-
vices for pipelines connecting major cities to
the main line stretching from the Bulgarian bor-
der to Ankara carrying natural gas imported from
USSR.

-Nova obtained the contract for the project
which is approx US \$3.5 million. Nova's current
contract with the Turkish Pipeline Corp. (BOTAS)
was also extended (US \$1.0 M).

QUARTER: 4 Asst. Cdn companies in follow-up natural gas
(NG) distribution projects
-Asst. Candev Energy Inc in compressed NG trans-
portation project with BOTAS

-2 Cdn companies are expected to bid
-BOTAS & Candev decided to conduct feasibility
studies separately & are currently working to
complete the studies.
