## NEW PAMPHLETS RELEASED BY MINISTER FOR INTERNATIONAL TRADE

Ottawa, June 1 -- The Minister for International Trade, Pat Carney, today made public brochures about industry, Provincial and Territorial interests in Canada's international trade negotiations, particularly those with the United States.

The brochures accompany an earlier publication titled Trade Negotiations: Securing Canada's Future.

Release of the material is consistent with the Minister's commitment in response to public demand to provide information on a continuing basis on the bilateral and multilateral talks which form Canada's two-track trade initiative.

Some 20 industrial sectors, the 10 Provinces and two Territories (combined in one pamphlet) are covered by the new material. In addition, there is a separate sheet discussing consumer interest in free trade and a three-page glossary of trade terminology.

The material is intended to indicate some of the issues for the sectors and regions in our trade negotiations with the United States and our other trading partners.

The information in the publications will be expanded once the details of any agreement become clear.
