

Parts of general Commerce began to resume its respective Force, and the Willingness which the Queen shewed, upon each Occasion, to facilitate all Designs whatsoever for the Improvement of her Dominions, the Employment of her Subjects, and the Sale of the Produce of their Industry, was so powerful in its Consequences, that by rapid Degrees, the Face of Things had undergone a total, and successful Alteration.
