For the information of Travellers between WINDSOR and PARRSBOROUGH.

THE Parrsborough Packet, Sails regularly between Windsor and Parrsborough twice in every Week, and occasionally three times; but is always at Windsor every Tuesday in the Summer Season (Wind and Weather permitting) so as to Sail from thence for Parrsborough, the first High Water that happens at, or after, Twelve o'clock on that Day.—The passage Money for each Person is five Shillings: And the Freight for Horses or Neat Cattle, is Seven Shillings and Six pence per Head—The vessel is Forty two Tons Burthen, and hath good accommodation for Passengers:—And likewise for taking over Horses, Neat Cattle and Sheep, &c.
