Great-who, nearly a thousyears ago, established and jury as a means by trial to the average justice of Cromwell, Hampden eitizen. and Pym are merely outstanding examples of those doughty Englishmen who down through the centuries have stood for the individual rights of the ordinary man, until Great Britain has become the most democratic of nations and the British Empire the only truly democratic league of nations in the world's history.

If we turn to other fields it was the English who gave the English language and English literature to the British Empire, the American Republic. and the world. Speaking as Reetor of St. Andrew's University Lord Rosebery has said Cambridge that Oxford and radiating were Universities sweetness and light for centuries before civilization began to make much headway in Scot-
