The egg industry in Denmark has been enormously improved owing to the application of the principle of co-operation to the collecting, grading, packing and export of the eggs. The great progress of Denmark during the past fifty years may be at once attributed to the wonderful system of education available for its people, and to the extent to which the principle of co-operation has been adopted in every part of the country and in every phase of its natural industry.

There has lately been formed a Poultry Production Association in Eastern Canada, based on the co-operative system. They do not hope at first to revolutionise or change the whole poultry industry," but they do, nevertheless, hope to remedy certain existing conditions which are greatly to the disadvantage of the industry as a whole. The Egg Station at Duncan was established with this end in view. The principal object of the station is to eliminate the "middle man" and thus increase the profits of the producer. A good market is sought where the best quality of produce is offered. Quality sells itself.
