Average demand for choice securities—Large Cash Reserves of New York Banks—What is Firmest—The inquiry in bonds in New York is far superior to that for stocks.

WALL-STREET STOCKS. While the general outlook is favorable in the perspective, and it is all well enough to talk of higher prices for stocks, definitely manufacturing interests will have to furnish evidence of vastly increased orders for goods before the immediate future tone of speculation will be materially improved.

Paid net earnings for December, showing an increase of \$148, is considerably better than expected, and will certainly stimulate buying of the stock.

NEW YORK, Jan. 30.—The sheriff today received an execution against William Lewis Boyle, banker, of No. 45 Wall-street, for \$7,988, in favor of the Bank of British North America, on a judgment obtained against him to-day for advances made by the bank to the Manitoba Milling and Manufacturing Company, which advances were guaranteed by Mr. Boyle and others, under an agreement made in June, 1935.
