Another pleasing feature is the increasing interest manifested by the employés of the manufacturing and other establishments of the City in the support of the Hospital; their contributions during the year exceeding those of 1870-71 by \$482.73.

In the list of churches in which collections have been taken up in aid of the Hospital will be found the names of five situated in several parts of the country, a gratifying evidence of the favor in which this charity

is held outside of Montreal.*

The number of in-door patients treated during the year has been one thousand five hundred and ninety-five (1595), which is an increase of thirty-six over that of the year immediately preceding it, and of two hundred and three (203) over that of 1869-70:
