## EUROPE IS BEARISH ON FINANCIAL SITUATION

A Wave of Caution—Is the Wall Street Market Top-Heavy? —Why the Bank of England Is so Extensively "Loaned Up"—The Problem of Russia.

(Special to N. Y. Evening Post.)  
LONDON, January 29.—A wave of caution seems for the moment to be passing over all of the world's financial markets. On this side of the Atlantic, it seems to be chiefly due to dislike of the Radical supremacy at the polls in our general election, to the Morocco dispute, to the continued doubts over Russian finance, and to uncertainty as to your own market's real position.  
Fears concerning the possible topheaviness of the American speculative position were more pronounced during the past week than for some time past. It is admitted, however, that the stagnation in other departments of the market here favors continued carrying of your position in this market. Moreover, it is believed that the groups of financiers back of your speculation are strong enough to liquidate gradually.  
Unless, therefore, the American public is engaged in the market more heavily than we suppose, our people believe that life and the boom is not yet witnessed. Numerous holdings of stocks must still be in the hands of these large operators. The feeling also is that increased dividends are probable, with a possible rise in the market value, under which your magnates should be able to effect general realizations. ## BUSINESS AND SHARE VALUES

An Unvarying Front of Strength and Apparent Permanency is Presented.

Davis & Co., New York.—It is only once in many years that the financial and business conditions of this country are other country present an unvarying front of strength and apparent permanency. Such is the situation in this country today, and it is difficult to speak even in terms of moderation of the extraordinary facts. Of course, there will be a reaction and a lean period, sooner or later. Unsettled business and unprecedented prosperity cannot continue indefinitely. But so far as one can judge the early future, there is no serious check in sight. It is not strange, therefore, that speculation in securities is being carried on with busy bright. Nor can it be said that operators have gone crazy in their determination to still further advance prices by leaps and bounds. Measured by possibilities (in many cases, certainly) the real value of railway stocks of some of the leading systems has increased in greater ratio than the market price. The same may be said of the general of the industrial. At the same time, the range of prices is so high for many accounts by stock speculators. Some forecasts and widespread opinion is that a rise will occur and the higher the level in such a case the more the movement and a lean period may be. The investor who can pay in full for carefully selected securities and lines the ultimate trend is upward, but the advance which is safe in the long run for the smaller and weaker man.  
There is no doubt that by reason of immense and profitable crops, and the consequent universal activity in mining, manufacturing and transportation, the supply of capital available for investment has enormously increased within the past twelve months. ## IT LOOKS LIKE EASIER MONEY

A Chicago View of the Present Market and the Outlook.

CHICAGO, Jan. 29.—A decided easing up in the money market is noticeable. It is neither more than most bankers expected three weeks ago, after the stringency. Money has loaned this week as low as 5 per cent, in large amounts in a few instances, but most of the money out was at 5 1/2 per cent, and some of the national banks loaned at 6 per cent. The rate is increasing in supply, and broken and local and interior bankers are buying it more readily at 5 to 5 1/2 per cent. Funds are returning from the interior in larger volume, and shipments of currency are increasing. The movement from the interior should be larger from this time forward. Many country bankers are increasing their balances here, which is taken as an indication that there is less call for their funds at home. Deposits of local banks are keeping up well, and with some institutions they have increased since the first of the year. This was due in a measure to the distribution of the Walsh accounts.  
In the bond market there is a revival of interest, not only among the investors, but on the part of the investors. The latter have been out of the market for several months, or practically since money came tight. Within the past few weeks there has been a gradual increase, only over the counter but in the open market.
