Canadian Blood Freely Shed For the Empire

55th Officer Killed

Former St. John Man Falls—Five Recruits Yesterday—Eight-Inch Guns For Major Allan's Battery—News of the Soldiers

According to the figures compiled by the Record Office, Ottawa, the total number of casualties among officers and men of the Canadian expeditionary forces is 49,026.

In the midnight casualty list appears the names of seven New Brunswick men: Wounded, Lance Corporal W. D. Smith, St. John; Sergeant Wilfred D. Stewart, Clarence street, St. John; Lance Corporal J. P. Phelan, Chatham; J. Anson Nelson, St. John; Alfred Reed, Minto; Louis P. Bradley, Sussex, and Lieut. Robert B. Campbell, Woodstock.

Was With 55th

Lieutenant Stewart Simpson, of Charlottetown, who was reported in yesterday's casualty list as killed in action, was a member of the 55th battalion and later the 5th C. M. R. He was in the staff of the Bank of Commerce in Halifax for two years. He was the son of Canon Simpson of All Saint's Cathedral, Charlottetown.

Killed in Action

That Private Albert McAlpine, formerly of this city who was killed in action, was the word received by his father, John D. McAlpine of Edmonton, who was in Ottawa yesterday. Private McAlpine was born here where several of his relatives still live, including Dr. McAlpine of Princess street and H. M. McAlpine of Horsfield street, who are uncles.

Five Recruits

Five recruits were secured yesterday in the city: B. K. Forsythe, St. John; Field Ambulance; George W. Watson, Bathurst, 286th Battalion; — Durham, Halifax, No. 9 Siege Battery, and O'Leary, Halifax, No. 9 Siege Battery.

Get Bigger Guns

The boys of No. 7 Siege Battery are to be equipped, when they arrive in France, with six eight-inch guns. It was reported some time ago that Major Allan's Battery would be sent to France with six-inch guns.

Gets New Office

It is reported in military circles that Captain Gordon McK. Johnston, of this city, of the 20th Battalion, who returned to Canada a few days ago, is to be made a new office. Captain Johnston is now in Ottawa.

Draft for 60th

It is understood that a draft of 100 men from the 60th battery, together with two officers, will proceed overseas.

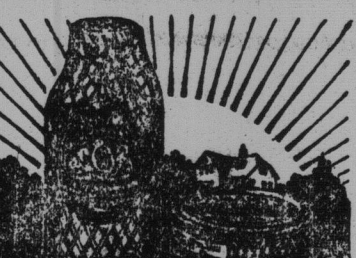

Tirade on Vanity Of Berlin Women

Attack on Them Because They Dress Well and Laugh Resented by Men in Trenches

Berlin, Oct. 12.—A wholly unmerited attention has been paid not only by the Berlin press, but by that of all Germany, to the extraordinary charges of a mediocre literary woman against gay Berlin, published in Count von Reventlow's Deutsche Tages Zeitung.

Marie Diers has actually seen elegantly dressed women laugh in the underground trains while the guns roareded their worst on the Somme. She was shocked at the crowded moving picture houses and theatres, and laughed at people visiting restaurants and cafes where they serve meals and drinks to Wagner or Strauss music, while hospitals are filling up at the front and maimed invalids are about everywhere. She despises the members of her own sex who do not go about in mourning, but crowd department stores in eagerness to adorn themselves, instead of staying at home knitting socks for the soldiers in the trenches. Summing up her impressions, Marie Diers ranks lowest in the cultural scale of though there was no war, and that Berlin ranks lowest in the cultural scale of the Empire.

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
