## TENTH ANNUAL COMMUNICATION

OF THE

### R. W. Grand Lodge of Canada West,

HELD IN LONDON, IN THE HALL OF FOREST CITY LODGE, NO. 38.

COMMENCING ON THE 3<sup>rd</sup> DAY OF AUGUST, A.D., 1864, AT 9 O'CLOCK, A. M.
