POSTAL DELIVERY

MONCTON, N. B., June 11.—Moneton is to have a free postal delivery system to go into effect in the very near future. This was the welcome news conveyed to the city by a telegram received this afternoon from Hon. H. R. Emmerson. M. P., at Ottawa. The message states that the Dominion Postal Department has issued instructions which provide for the establishment of free mail delivery here. This reform has been in the air for some time, and is one which will be welcomed by the citizens. The city council has taken the necessary steps in having the houses numbered, and in the near future the Moncton man will be able to get his mail delivered at his house, instead of tramping after it.
