During that time he heard no outcry, and at no time saw the accused.

Robert Douglas, city fireman, swore that there was a fire at Cushing's mill on Aug. 2.

William Lavigne, 30 Clarence street, deposed that his daughter Hattle and Sadie McAuley brought him his dinner on noon of that day, and that they then went to pick berries. He did not see the accused or any one follow them.
