Sir,

I, the undersigned, J. J. Crevier, of the parish of St. Amant, Notary Public, duly appointed agent, beg leave to report as follows, upon the title of John D. McMillan, of the township of Dundee aforesaid, farmer, in connection with that lot known and designated on the official plan and book of reference of the said township of Dundee as lot N^o 12, on the 1st range of Dundee aforesaid, containing ninety acres and twenty perches, in superficies, more or less, to wit:

1^o The said lot was originally leased by the Indian Chiefs of St. Regis to one Benjamin Phillips, under a lease reported to be on record in the Indian Department at Ottawa, which lease cannot however be produced.

2^o The said Benjamin Phillips transferred his own claims in said lot to
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
