BILL.

An Act to authorize the Courts of Chancery, Queen's Bench, and Common Pleas in Upper Canada respectively, to admit certain persons to practice in such Courts.

WHEREAS numerous applications are made to the Legislature at Preamble. every Session for Acts to authorize the Courts of Chancery Queen's Bench, and Common Pleas in Upper Canada, in the irdiscretion to admit persons to practice as Attorneys or Solicitors in the said Courts respectively; And whereas a great many such Acts have passed the Legislature and become Law, and it is desirable, in order to prevent such a multiplicity of Acts, to authorize by one general Law the said Courts to admit any duly qualified person to practice as a Solicitor or Attorney in the said Courts respectively; Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the 10 consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

I. It shall be lawful for the said Courts respectively in their discretion Enacting Clause. to admit any person entitled to practice as an Attorney or Solicitor in any of Her Majesty's Dominions, to practice as such in the said Courts 15 respectively, any Law or Usage to the contrary notwithstanding.
