5. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Fifteen thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, for Arts, Agriculture and Statistics—To promote the establishment and maintenance of Creameries in the North-west Territories, for the year ending 30th June, 1897.

6. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Thirty-five thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, to enable the Agricultural and Dairy Commissioner to promote dairying interests by advances for milk and cream, and for making butter in creameries in the North-west Territories, to be recouped out of the proceeds of sales of such butter to be placed to the credit of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, for the year ending 30th June, 1897.

7. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Four hundred and sixteen dollars and sixty-six cents be granted to Her Majesty, for two months' gratuity to Mrs. W. McNaughton Jones, widow of the late Dr. W. McNaughton Jones, General Superintendent of Quarantines in British Columbia (salary, \$2,500), for the year ending 30th June, 1897.

8. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Three thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, for Cattle Quarantine, for the year ending 30th June, 1897.

9. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Twenty thousand dollars be granted to Her Majesty, towards providing for cold storage and carriage of Canadian perishable food products, and to secure recognition of the quality of such products in the markets of Great Britain in an undeteriorated condition, for the year ending 30th June, 1897.

10. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Three thousand eight hundred dollars be granted to Her Majesty, for Militia—Towards the erection of an orderly room attached to the drill shed at Charlottetown, \$500; Compensation to Mrs. Mary Burns, widow of the late Corporal J. Burns, Royal Regiment Canadian Infantry, \$300; Royal Military College of Canada—To provide for two months' pay, \$527.22, and travelling expenses to place of abode of Major General D. R. Cameron, C.M.G., late Commandant of the Royal Military College at Kingston, \$1,600; Bisley medals, \$200; To repair military wharf at St. Helen's Island, Montreal, \$1,200, for the year ending 30th June, 1897.

11. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Four thousand one hundred and forty-seven dollars and fifty cents be granted to Her Majesty, for Rebellion, North-west Territories—To pay Lt.-Col. Achille Fraser, 88th Battalion Militia, 1,185 days' subsistence allowance up to August, 1888, at \$3.50 per diem, while employed on special service at Winnipeg (approved by Order in Council, 10th April, 1896), for the year ending 30th June, 1897.

12. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Three thousand three hundred and fifty dollars be granted to Her Majesty, for Railways—Intercolonial—To provide a loading platform and siding at St. François Station, \$350; To pay for land and damages in Cape Breton and Oxford and New Glasgow Railway, \$3,000, for the year ending 30th June, 1897.

13. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Two thousand two hundred and twenty-six dollars be granted to Her Majesty, for Welland Canal—Differences in value of land exchanged with the Grand Trunk Railway, for the year ending 30th June, 1897.

14. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Five hundred dollars be granted to Her Majesty, to defray cost of maintaining Government dredge when dredging on the River Scugog, for the year ending 30th June, 1897.

15. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Six thousand five hundred dollars be granted to Her Majesty, for Canals—Rideau Canal—To dredge Cataragui River between Kingston and Kingston Mills, \$3,000; To complete work of deepening at Merricksville and Newboro', \$3,500, for the year ending 30th June, 1897.

16. Resolved, That a sum not exceeding Two hundred dollars be granted to Her Majesty, to pay two months' salary as a gratuity to Mrs. McMillen, widow of the late paymaster, Lachine Canal, for the year ending 30th June, 1897.
