C A P. XXI.

An Ordinance to declare and regulate the tolls to be taken on the Bridge over Cap-Rouge River, and for other purposes relative to the said Bridge.

WHEREAS by a certain Ordinance made and passed in Preamble.
the second year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled,
"An Ordinance to provide for the completion of certain public
works, for the improvement of the internal communications,
and for the encouragement of agriculture, and for other pur-
poses," the sum of one thousand pounds currency was appro-
priated to enable Her Majesty to purchase from the Seigneur of
the Seignior of Cap-Rouge, in the District of Quebec, the
right of toll over the River Cap-Rouge, and a further sum of
one thousand pounds currency, to defray the expense of build-
ing a bridge over the said River, and it was Ordained and
Enacted that the said right of toll and the said Bridge, when
so purchased and built, should be vested in Her Majesty for
the public uses of the Province; and whereas by a certain
other Ordinance made and passed in the third year of Her
Majesty's Reign, a further sum of one hundred and eighty-five
pounds, eight shillings currency, was appropriated to defray
the expense of building the said Bridge; and whereas the
said sums have been expended, and the said right of toll hath
been purchased, and a Bridge built, according to the provisions
of the said Ordinances, near the mouth of the said river, and
it is expedient to declare and regulate the tolls which shall be
taken from the persons using the said Bridge, and to provide
means for keeping the said bridge in repair and renewing the
same or any part thereof when necessary:—Be it therefore
Ordained and Enacted by His Excellency the Governor of this
Province of Lower-Canada, by and with the advice and con-
sent of the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province,
constituted and assembled by virtue and under the authority
of an Act of the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great
Britain and Ireland, passed in the first year of the Reign of
Her present Majesty, intituled, "*An Act to make temporary*
