Q: How does the plan work when I need to get a prescription?

A: Present your pay direct card to the pharmacist when picking up your prescription. You will pay the uncovered portion. The pay direct card is accepted by over 90% of all drugstores in Canada (*The pharmacist is reimbursed directly by the insurance company*).

Just think, no trips to a business office and no forms to fill out every time you need to get a prescription.

Q: Are oral contraceptives included in the Student Health Plan?

A: Yes, they are. Oral contraceptives are not only the most frequently claimed drugs but they are also the single most important drug included in a student health plan.

Q: What if I am already covered under another health plan (i.e. parents)?

A: The Student Health Plan includes an opt-out clause for those students who may already be covered under another health plan (spouse's, employers' or parents'). Visit the Student Union within the first four to six weeks of classes.

Q: Will the Student Health Plan cover my kids and spouse?

A: Yes, simply go to the Student Union to pay the additional fee (usually the first four to six weeks of classes which corresponds to the opt-out period).

Q: Does "spouse" include same-sex partners?

A: Yes, it does. The Student Health Plan also covers common-law partners.
