Sir,-

I beg to inform you that sealed tenders for the delivery at Winnipeg and Prince Albert of the Garden Seeds mentioned in the enclosed schedules will be received by this Department up to the hour of twelve o'clock noon on Monday the 24th January 1910.

In case of seeds required for Agencies as per list marked "A" delivery may be made by freight not later than the 21st February next, and in the case of seeds to be delivered to the Rev. J. Semmens and, Mr. W. J. Chisholm delivery should be made by express as soon as possible after the awarding of the contract.

The seeds should be put up and marked as called for by the foot notes on the different schedules; but they may be shipped to Winnipeg and Prince Albert in bulk packages.

The contractors will prepay the freight and express charges to the above points.

The seeds should be put up in strong cotton bags and in oiled or waxed paper wrapped, so that they can be safely trans-shipped from the points of delivery.

Each parcel should contain a list of the seeds enclosed.
