Sir,--

Mr. Frank Barnett of Vancouver called at the Department to-day and asked on behalf of Mr. Robert Kelly of that place for permission to land fish on the Quwvheleh Reserve, which is at the head of Smith Sound and in the Kwakweth Agency, and to use the shore for the purpose of seining. I have informed him that I would write you on the subject, and that you would give permission to this being done if there were no valid objections against it. I am informed that the Indians do not reside on the reserve.
