I have to request that you will kindly supply five Sir: gallons of castor oil to Dr. Jos. F.X.Bosse, Indian Agent at Bersimis, P.Q., for use on behalf of Indians, The oil supplied should be of the best quality and should be placed in a vessel in which it will be quite safe. Shipment should be made to Dr. Bosse at Bersimis via Rimouski. You should advise him of the date of shipment, and also send him your account in duplicate, as his certificate thereto is required before payment can be made. You should attach to the account a receipt for the prepaid shipment charges.
