- A. In the vegetable room.
- Q.14 What part of your body?
- A. On the face, on the jaw.
- Q.15 What with?
- A. His fist.
- Q.16 The second time?
- A. The same thing, sir, in the hallway.
- Q.17 Who else was in the hut L.11 at the time?
- A. There was Bdr. Hughes, Bdr. Daniels, myself, Cpl. Richmond, and there was a Gunner Coll and Gunner Lemont, and a Ber. from the other kitchen, I just forget his name, he came over when the disturbance was on. That is all I can remember.
- Q.18 Will you describe to the Court the actions of L/Cpl. Richmond during this?
- A. At the time when I came in, he was defending himself or fighting back, and we broke it up, and he was alright. He cooled down, and Lecompte went after him again. Coming back to the kitchen after I had been at the Guard Room to see if Richmond was hurt, I saw that his knees were bruised up, and his back, but otherwise he was alright.
- Q.19 At the time you separated Cpl. Richmond and Gnr. Lecompte what was the condition of Lecompte?
- A. He was pretty mad. He lost his temper and was yelling and cursing.
- Q.20 What was his physical condition?
- A. As far as drinking, he had been drinking, or gave me the impression he had been. Otherwise he looked perfectly alright to me.
- Q.21 What was the physical condition of Gnr. Lecompte when you picked him up to take him to the Guard Room?
- A. His face was bleeding. I thought it was his nose, when I picked him up off the floor to take him to the Guard Room.
- Q.22 Were you hurt?
- A. No, sir.
- Q.23 What was your duty at this time?
- A. I was at the Grenade Theatre and returning. I was not on duty.
- Q.24 De you know what Gmr. Lecompte's duty at that time was?
- A. No, sir.
