Re-A.H. Lomas' Shortages.

In reply to your letter of the 1st instant, number 194/24189. I beg to inform you that the error on page 51 of Mr. C.W. O'Neill's report has been corrected, and to the statement of Mr. Lomas' shortages we had added \$857.88, on account of the Qualicum Indians. The distribution of funds available will be made on a basis of 42.26%, and I am enclosing amended statement of proposed payments from which you will observe that the Qualicum Band is entitled to \$362.54.

The sum of \$570.49, representing amount to be distributed among the Somenos Indians as compensation for right of way of the Canadian National Railway, will be held as suggested by you.
