CAP. LXIV.

An Act for the construction of WATER WORKS in the City of Hamilton.

[Assented to 19th June, 1856.]

WHEREAS the construction of Water Works and a supply of water would conduce to the health and comfort of the inhabitants of the May of Hamilton: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and ment of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as fol-

I. The persons hereafter to be elected in the manner provided for in this and their successors, shall constitute a Board, to be called and known the Water Commissioners for the City of Hamilton.

II. It shall be the duty of the said Commissioners to examine, consider decide upon all matters relative to supplying the said City of Hamilton th a sufficient quantity of pure and wholesome water for the use of its habitants, and the amount of money necessary to effect that object.

III. The said Commissioners shall have power to employ engineers, suryors and such other persons as in their opinion may be necessary to enable m to fulfil their duties under this Act.

IV. It shall and may be lawful for the said Commissioners, their agents, vants and workmen, from time to time, and at such times hereafter as shall see fit, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to enter inand upon the lands of any person or persons, bodies politic or corporate, the City of Hamilton, or within twenty miles of the said city, and to vey, set out and ascertain such parts thereof as they may require the purposes of the said Water Works, and also to divert and appropriate
