The undersigned, a Committee appointed by your honorable body, on the twenty-sixth day of December, 1900, to examine the Annual Statement of the Company, and to verify the same, respectfully

REPORT.

That, pursuant to the power and authority thereby conferred, the Committee have at various dates between the date of the said reference and the date of this Report, attended at the office of the Company, and have been waited on by the Treasurer, the Comptroller, the Auditor and the Cashier, together with the respective assistants of such officers, and have carefully gone over all the items contained in the said statement, and do have found the same to be correct. They have examined and counted every certificate of stock, bond and other obligation issued by the Company, and compared the prices at which the same are carried in said statement with the market quotations, and find the same not exceeding such quotations; in fact, in many cases below them. They have examined and counted the bonds and mortgages on real property held by the Company, and find the same to be as stated. They have approved the valuations of the Company's holdings of real estate, and have verified the deposits of money in the various banks and trust companies, and have counted the cash on hand held by the Cashier.

And the Committee certify that all the books, papers, documents, and evidence of title of every description necessary in such examination have been freely submitted to the Committee by the said officers and their assistants and that the same are accurate, in good order and well kept.

And the Committee further certify that the investments of the Company are of a high order, and that the system and methods adopted by the Company in recording its transactions and caring for the assets are entitled to commendation.
