VICTORIA, by the Grace of God, of the United
Kingdom of *Great Britain and Ireland*, Queen,

To our well-beloved and faithful, the Legislative
Councillors of the Province of *Canada*, and the Knights,
Citizens, and Burgesses, elected to serve in the Legis-
lative Assembly of our said Province, summoned and
called to a meeting of the Provincial Parliament of
our said Province, at our town of *Kingston*, on Thurs-
day, the eighth day of September, now next ensuing,
to have been commenced and held, and to every of
you—

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the meeting of our Provincial Par-
liament stands called *for the Despatch of*
Business, on Thursday, the eighth day of September
next, at our town of *Kingston*, at which place you
were held and constrained to appear: Now Know
Ye, that we do will that you, and each of you, be as
to us in this matter entirely exonerated; commanding,
and by the tenor of these Presents enjoining you, and
every of you, and all others in this behalf interested,

that on Thursday, the eighth day of September next,
in our township of *Kingston*, you personally be and
appear, *for the Despatch of Business*, to treat, do, act,
and conclude, upon those things, which in our said
Provincial Parliament, of our said Province, may by
the favour of God be ordained.

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In testimony whereof, we have caused these our Let-
ters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of
our said Province of *Canada* to be hereunto
affixed:

Witness our right trusty and well-beloved the Right
Honourable Sir *Charles Bagot*, G. C. B. one of
our most Honourable Privy Council, Governor-
General of British *North America*, and Captain-
General and Governor-in-Chief in and over our
Provinces of *Canada*, *Nova Scotia*, *New Brun-*
swick, and the Island of *Prince Edward*, and
Vice-Admiral of the same, &c. &c. &c.

At *Kingston*, this twenty-third day of August, in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and forty-two, and in the sixth year of our reign.
