V. And be it enacted, That if any such Masters Masters, &c. neaforesaid shall neglect or refuse to make such Re-sing to make Ke-port as herein directed, or shall make a false Report, port, to forfeit und shall for failed and the state of the state such Master shall be liable, and shall forfeit and pay, for every such offence, / a Fine not exceeding One hundred Pounds.

VI. And be it enacted, That all Fines, For- Mode of recovery feitures and Penalties arising by operation of the penalties and penalties arising by operation of the penalties imposed herein-before recited Act, or this Act, or any other by this or any Act relating to the Revenue of this Island, shall Act. be sued for and recovered, together with Costs. in His Majesty's Court of Vice Admiralty; any thing contained in any other Law to the contrary notwithstanding-and the Monies arising from such Penalties, Fines and Forfeitures, shall be applied, one half to and for the purposes for which the said Duties are granted, and the other half to him or them who shall inform, seize, or suc for the same.
